Subject: Keep Our Bus Stops Safe! petition

Dear TfL colleagues

I just wanted to let you know that our Trust has just started an online petition asking TfL to rethink plans for a 'floating' bus stop outside St Thomas' Hospital. Our Trust Secretary has already informed your Managing Director about this.

It is being supported by other local stakeholders including Kate Hoey MP and groups representing hospital patients, blind people and pensioners.

All are concerned about the safety risks to vulnerable road users - both pedestrians and cyclists - because people getting off the buses outside St Thomas' would need to walk across a cycle lane to get to the hospital.
